- State of the Union (Kristina Howard) 10 minutes
  - Celebrations slide: Dragon auction (parent feedback to norm on-points)
  - PTA donated \$150 worth of gift cards
  - Students want food, gift cards, Bluetooth speakers, sports equipment
  - Second semester updates to district board meeting work session Tuesday, January 22nd (not an open board meeting? OPEN: Students and parents can testify, Christina welcomes parents and students). This information will also be shared with coffee with the principal.
    - Math and reading support based on MAPS data.
    - Support for core instruction. Math was today, ELA and S.S. and DLI planning periods in January
    - Tuesday staff meetings will focus on instructional focus; including restorative justice, AVID strategies, critical reading, etc.
    - Thinking towards next year: looking at the master schedule with student choice, data-driven, returning staff, staff recruitment starting as soon as possible as needed.
    - MAPS data in May again, SBAC at end of the year also
  - Kelly= Are schedules in parentvue real?
    - There may still be changes, can put communication in the newsletter. New electives are opening up per teacher volunteering new classes. Can ask for schedule changes early in 2nd semester.
  - Newsletter posted on Ockley website Sunday but emailed today. Next newsletter goes out on Wednesday? Can try and get out newsletters out on Fridays?
- MAPS update:
  - NWEA test, reading and math, tested 3 times a year.
  - School-wide goal is that 50% of students reach their academic growth goal given in October.
  - This test round was scheduled school-wide over 2 days by advisory class. Students stayed with advisory class for 2 days, tested either in AM or PM and then had free-time/make-up work/team building/grade reflection the other half of the day. Extended recess/lunch time.
  - Incentives for valid tests and for meeting mid-year growth goal: certificates, public recognition, SEI points, dance
  - Less than 20 students needed to be pulled from class today and tomorrow to finish testing (versus over 100 in the Fall)
  - Preliminary test results show growth in math and reading in all 3 grade levels
  - Complete test results will be released in early February
  - Kelly- can we have this level of testing without so much free time, instead focus on end of quarter grades. Christina: That was recommended and it was teacher dependent on what was done exactly. Not ideal that testing window was at end of quarter. Also led to last minute communication. Need more from district in this area.
    - Planning for testing schedules needs to start sooner and communicated sooner.
