- ODE TAG audit - OGMS is standout MS for TAG
 - Most active students
 - Evidence of positive relationship between teachers and students
 - Use of technology was exceptional
 - Consistent use of exit tickets
 - Feedback: being more purposeful, use of success criteria
 - Observed again on 11.17.20
 - Strategically picked teachers who may need more support
 - Growth areas: use of pre-assessment, breakout groups to support different levels based on pre-assessment
 - Teacher talk time is too heavy
 - Use of exit tickets and lack of alignment
 - Person is open to leading future PDs
- Math PLC
 - Shown to other schools districtwide
 - OGMS Math is “exemplary”
- Cross Curricular PLC
 - Teacher idea!
 - PLC leads visited each other’s PLCs and reviewed other’s Canvas pages
 - This was successful and will happen again approximately once a month
- Kids showing up to Meets but not engaging in academic work
 - OGMS is troubleshooting
 - Aligning Canvas pages
 - Template coming that will be imported into every OGMS teacher’s page
- Student Success Survey

- Being given in Math classes next week
- Data will be reviewed so PLCs can have some very “real” conversations
- Results will be shown (confidentially) to Site Council next month
- Grading
 - Running reports and analyzing grades with staff
 - Hope for a whole school policy on grading
- Conferences
 - Families with MS and HS students cannot attend both, it is not possible in the formats given by MS and HS
 - Messaging coming from teachers is not consistent, some teachers being very clear about conferences to families, some are confusing parents
 - Possible parent survey to follow-up after conferences (for parent feedback)
- New Business (40 minutes)
 - Develop school survey questions
 - Aligned to SCIP goal: **By the end of the year, we will have the following percent participating in the Successful Schools Survey: Students - 70%; Staff 80%; and Family 50%.**
 - Per the SCIP, we had us collecting baseline data November 2020, do we do this at conferences? Or something different this year?
 - Will likely be given the first week of December
 - Scale back survey and simplify for families
 - It assumes a higher reading and language level, not accessible
 - Only 49 families responded last year
 - Combine the previous OG conference exit survey and the successful school survey, take out irrelevant questions to CDL
 - Team edited survey to be more relevant and user friendly.
