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## **Cleveland High School Community**

Cleveland High School is one of nine public high schools in Portland, Oregon. An urban high school in inner southeast Portland, Cleveland draws from socio-economically mixed neighborhoods and serves a diverse population of approximately 1700 students. As a four-year comprehensive high school, Cleveland is respected for its high academic standards in all content areas, multiple opportunities in the fine and performing arts, and a warm and accepting school climate. Cleveland has a comprehensive English Language Learners program and opportunities for selected students to participate in the Reed College Young Scholars program.

The Cleveland community is proud to be recognized as one of more than 5500 International Baccalaureate World Schools in 159 countries and one of only two high schools in Portland Public Schools. As a member of this international school community, Cleveland offers strong core academic programs across the curriculum that build college and career readiness skills and encourage students to embrace the IB mission to become active, compassionate and lifelong learners who understand that other people, with their differences, can also be right.

Every student at Cleveland participates in four IB classes in their junior and senior years (IB English Literature HL or IB Language & Literature HL- 2 years; IB Biology HL or SL; IB History of the Americas HL). Most take additional IB classes, and over 15% annually complete all academic requirements to earn the internationally-recognized IB Diploma.

## Rank Order and GPA

Cleveland High School computes both unweighted and weighted GPAs.\* Unweighted rank and GPA is calculated based on the cumulative grade point average of all classes on a four-point scale. Weighted GPA

is recalculated with a weighted differential based on a five-point scale for International Baccalaureate classes only. The highest weighted GPA for the class of 2021 was 4.443.

\*Portland Public Schools, in response to required guidance from the Oregon Department of Education, moved to Passing (P) and Incomplete (INC) grades for all high school coursework beginning March 2020 due to COVID-19 school closures and the state's shift to distance learning. This grading adjustment is reflected on the Spring 2020 portion of student transcripts. Proficiency-based credit was issued for coursework which met Oregon Department of Education guidelines for demonstrating appropriate skills in selected content areas. These credits are noted on a student's transcript with "proficiency" next to the course name (i.e. Eng 4- Proficiency) and a grade of P (Pass).
