- The Rhine-Lafayette Pedestrian Overpass in southeast Portland will close Monday, Nov. 19 through Wednesday, Nov. 21, as TriMet makes improvements to increase the reliability of the bridge's elevators
- The improvements will take about seven weeks and require the full closure of the overpass at times
