IB Exam Registration for Juniors and Seniors is OPEN!

Juniors and seniors interested in registering for IB assessment must...

- complete registration on Naviance
- pay required fees
- sign and submit a copy of registration and required signatures by **Wednesday, Oct. 31 at noon.**

When should I register?

Students should **wait to register until the 2nd year of an IB-titled course, except** for the following courses...

IB Mandarin Chinese B SL (immersion)

IB Psychology SL

IB Social and Cultural Anthropology SL

IB Environmental Systems and Societies SL

IB Biology SL 3-4 (juniors who took Academy Biology in 9th grade)

IB Chemistry SL 1-2

IB Environmental Systems and Societies SL

IB Math Studies SL

IB Music SL

Parking Lot POLICY

This message is to remind all students that the school parking lots (one is on SE 26th and Franklin and the other is on SE 28th and Powell) are **staff only** parking. Students are not authorized to park in either parking lot. (Only one student is authorized to park in the lot because the family purchased a space at the Cleveland Auction.)

An increasing number of students are parking illegally in both lots, which has forced administration to be more diligent in enforcing the existing policy: “ **Students are not permitted in either parking lot.** Parking lots are reserved for staff and authorized visitors only.”

Parking lot violation consequences:

- First Violation: a warning sticker will be placed on the vehicle window.
- Second Violation: the vehicle will receive a \$30 parking ticket.
- Third Violation: the vehicle will be towed at owner’s expense.
