My goal is to meet all of the Skyline families. On Wednesday, I was able to visit Outdoor School. A huge thank you to Megan Kindred for subbing for me so I could go. The students were having a blast and were engaged in the learning activities led by the camp counselors. I was very impressed with the facility and the staff.

In our data meetings we identified how we will differentiate our instruction to meet the needs of all learners while implementing our interventions. It is our goal to see our SBAC scores and overall student achievement increase. I have very high hopes for our amazing staff, students and families.

Our teachers are working hard to streamline our communication in grades K-5 for conferences. 
