Happy Friday. Please do not forget Monday is Presidents' Day and there is no school. Wednesday, February 21, is a late start day with school beginning at 10:45 am.

This week our 7th graders participated in The 7GCTE - 7th Grade Career Tech Exploration that was developed to establish a middle grade system for career readiness and to build and expand awareness of college and career opportunities among 7th graders and their families. Students practiced skills that are critical to success in high-demand, high-wage careers and learned about the CTE programs of study available to them in fields such as engineering, manufacturing, information technology, healthcare, design and much more.

Designed to inspire and embolden middle school students, the 7GCTE is a new Portland Public Schools program to provide all PPS 7th graders with an annual and immersive hands-on learning experience. The program is delivered over eight months during the school year, from October – May. Learning experiences are nine-hours long for three consecutive days (10AM - 1PM daily) and students are transported to off-site locations that include college campuses and corporate headquarters. The 7GCTE is an opportunity for students to develop design thinking skills while supporting confidence, curiosity and self-directed problem solving. PPS contracts with multiple providers of hands-on learning experiences to deliver the program. Thank you PPS for this awesome experience for our 7th graders.

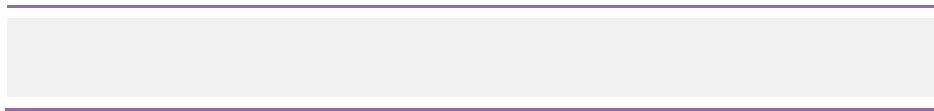
