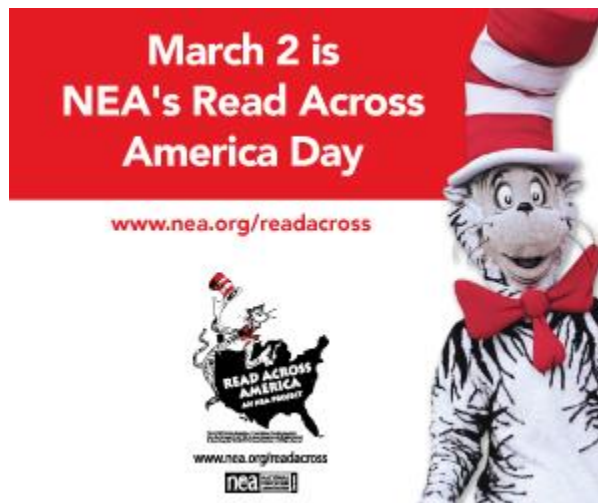
## Read Across America
