Fee: \$30 *for all five sessions for those who register for spring rec soccer*

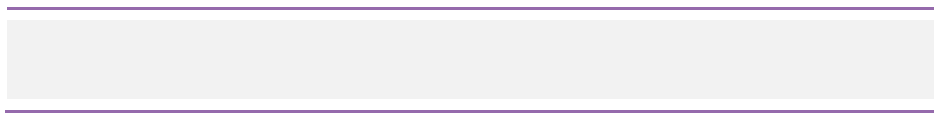
Parents of K/1st-5th graders, you will register your child for the Sunday Academy Trainings Package when you register for spring rec soccer with SSC at the link above.
