IB Corner

***Come One, Come All!!! Next Thursday, May 24th from 6-8pm
is the 1st Annual IB Night at Skyline***

This year we are combining two events into a shared celebration so that more families and students can celebrate the inquiry learning we have done this year. There will be snacks as well as mini inquiry opportunities for all ages.

Here at Skyline our Primary Years Program 4th & 5th grade students participate in a culminating learning experience known as **Exhibition**. The IBO describes it as,

...an extended, in-depth, collaborative project... This involves students working collaboratively to conduct an in-depth inquiry into real life issues or problems. Students collectively synthesise all of the essential elements of the PYP in ways that can be shared with the whole school community. - IBO

In our Middle Years Program, students are required to participate in service to their community. This culminates in a Community Action Project. The MYP IB Community Action Project allows Skyline 8th graders to use all the skills of inquiry to work independently on a project of their own design that positively impacts the community in which they live. According to the IB, the **Community Project**: “encourages students to explore their right and responsibility to implement service as action in the community.”

4th & 5th Graders will be in the upstairs hallway and 8th Graders will be downstairs presenting their projects and answering any inquiries you have about their topics. We will have mini-inquiries for families to try in the library, and snacks in the Skyline Gym.
