- Dinner will not be provided for children;
- All children will participate in 4 Stations of games, activities, and art;
- Movies and Popcorn: 2 choices: <u>Peanuts Movie</u> (rated G) or <u>Kubo and the Two Strings</u> (rated PG). Be sure to check your preference when registering. Children will not be permitted to watch the PG movie without parent permission.

Ensure immunizations are updated or follow *PPS opt-out procedures* by Wednesday, February 15. Multnomah Education Service District has mailed notifications to parents of students who are missing one or more of the required immunizations. If you received this notification, you'll need to provide the school office with shot dates or provide a medical exemption certificate (see below) before Wednesday, February 15. Students whose records are incomplete on February 15 will not be able to attend school until dates or a medical exemption certificate is on file in the school office. Please contact our school nurse, Mary Corcoran at mccrora@mesd.k12.or.us if you have questions.

Medical exemption certificate: For parents who choose not to have their student immunized, or if students are on a delayed immunization schedule:

- Parents are required by Oregon law to complete education on the vaccines they are choosing not to be given to their student. Each module on the specific diseases takes about 20 minutes.
 Visit the website to complete these modules.
- Print the certificate for each child.
- Bring the certificate to the school secretary.
- Complete "Section B" on the Certificate of Immunization status.
- Sign an updated signature with a date on the Certificate of Immunization status.
