Community Event - Learn about Chapman's recently restored WPA Wood Mural, Dec. 1st 6-8pm

As many of you know, the Chapman PTA was awarded generous grants last Spring to restore the WPA wood mural that surrounds the auditorium in the front lobby of Chapman. We are hosting a community educational event for anyone interested in learning more about this project, the artist Aimee Gorham, the restoration process and the WPA (the New Deal program that employed millions of Americans during the Great Depression). This free event is funded by an educational grant from Neighbors West Northwest and we hope to see you there! You will also get a first glimpse of the new wood marquetry auditorium sign and new educational panels that will permanently accompany the mural to provide information about this important historical piece. Although the presentations at the event are geared more towards an adult audience, there will be childcare (for children ages 3+ that are potty-trained) with child-friendly activities held in the art room.
