# Principal's Message

Dear Ockley Green Families and Community,

This newsletter is full of information for our families that directly reflects the wonderful programs we have at OG. Our OG band will be participating in the Middle School Band Festival at Wilson High School this Thursday and our Chess Team has been asked to attend the State Tournament at the Oregon Convention Center on March 9th. Thank-you Mr. Littledyke, Mr. Matsen for bringing these excellent opportunities to our students and the Ockley Green families who support both of these programs. Good luck! There is information about our next Lockdown drill, on Monday, March 12th included as well. The safety and security of our students is our highest priority. As you recall families received an email from George Weatheroy, Director of Security at PPS on February 15th. I want to include a portion of it here and to reiterate the importance of our students and families informing us when they perceive a safety or security concern whether at school, online via social media channels or outside of school. The Safe Oregon Tip Line is not only for students, but for families as well.

He stated: "PPS has made a number of security investments in our schools that include improved communications, installation of access control and video surveillance systems and an increased number of Campus Security Agents. These safety investments on our campuses will continue with the 2017 bond money. In addition, all of our emergency procedures are analyzed every year for national best practice review. PPS promotes a culture of safety by encouraging and empowering our students to report anything that makes them feel unsafe. # Safety at Ockley Green

As part of the District's multi-hazard plan, schools are required to conduct two lockdown drills each academic year in fall and spring. Our second lockdown drill of the year will happen this month. On Monday, March 12 at 10:00 AM we will conduct an announced lock down drill. A lockdown is put into action when there is an immediate threat inside our building.

During a lockdown drill we practice/review the following procedures:

Teachers immediately bring students into the classroom and:

- lock the door
- cover interior windows
- turn out lights
- move students away from the line of sight
- maintain silence
- take attendance
- wait for First Responders to open the door

If students and staff are outside they are to evacuate the campus and find a safe location away from the school. Even if someone comes over the loudspeaker, knocks at a door, makes a phone call to rooms that students can leave the classroom, students and staff shall remain in lockdown only until a First Responder unlocks the door with a key to evacuate the building. In the event the fire alarm sounds during a lockdown the adults in the room are asked to determine if there is any immediate danger if they remain in the classroom or evacuate.

## Chromebooks Agreement

We are thankful to have many Chromebooks to share throughout the school so that students can engage in 21st century digital skills. This allows our students to have access to resources and supports in all their classrooms. To that end, teachers will be reviewing Chromebook expectations with all of their students and asking them to sign the <a href="OG Chromebook Agreement">OG Chromebook Agreement</a> as a way to improve our school-wide use of technology.
