Principal's Message

Dear Ockley Green Families and Community,

I hope everyone was able to enjoy the beautiful weather over the weekend. It certainly makes a difference to have a little sunshine in our lives. In this newsletter I want to be sure you know about two important events happening at OG this week:

17 Minutes of Silence

On Wednesday, March 14th we will join other schools in the national observance of holding seventeen minutes of silence for the 17 students who lost their lives during the tragedy at Marjorie Stoneman-Douglas HS in Florida last month. As you may have read in a letter from Superintendent Guerrero, we have been asked to plan a visible, school-wide event. At 10 am on Wednesday, we are inviting our classes to come out to the OG field where we will stand together to form the number 17. You are invited to join us. We are encouraging everyone to wear black that day if they can. If students do not want to participate, a supervised space will be available for them in the building. Some teachers are planning events for the day. Those events will be on campus and may coincide with the gathering on the field. If you would like to join us, please arrive early so that you can check in at the main office and pick up a visitors badge.
