Principal's Message

Good morning Ockley Green Families and Community,

This is a busy time of year as we look forward to Spring Break, but know that on the other side is the important work we need to do, to not only prepare for end of year events, but look ahead to planning for 2018-2019. To that end, some of our students will start their Smarter Balanced Assessments the second week of April. Mr. Jamieson has been working on testing schedules and will send our more information after Spring Break.

Staffing and scheduling for next year is underway. PPS is looking at a common six period schedule across most middle schools. This means Ockley will move away from the 90 minute, A/B block schedule that we had this year. Periods will be around 60 minutes and students will have core subjects every day including social studies and science. We are looking at maintaining our current electives of music, including band, art, dance, Mock Trials, STEAM and PE. All students are required to have one quarter of health so we will be building that into the 2018-2019 schedule as well.

My mornings in the office have been enlivened with the wonderful sound of our marching band. Mr. Littledyke meets each morning at 8:15 with the students. They run a few laps (you can't march 3 miles with a tuba on your shoulder unless you're fit) and then start to practice. It's a wonderful sound and reminds me that Ockley students are incredibly talented and dedicated to their learning. I hope we can all support our band when they march in the St. Johns parade on May 12th. I wish all students and families a relaxing and enjoyable Spring Break. Thank-you for making Ockley Green the great school it is.
