Good morning Ockley Green Families and Community,

I want to thank all of the families for supporting the new cell phone and device policy we started last Monday. We saw a dramatic reduction in phone use and an increase in learning and focus in the classroom. Having the phones 'off and away' all day makes a difference to the climate of our school in a positive way. We will send a survey out to families at the end of the quarter to get your perspective on the policy.
