40 Day Rule

We expect all our 8th graders to complete their last days at Ockley Green M.S. showing respect and leadership.

Eighth graders will not be allowed to participate in the 8th grade BBQ, Seaside trip, promotion dance and/or promotion if they engage in the following behaviors during the last 40 days of school:

Vandalism

Fighting

Transfer, sale or under the influence of drugs or alcohol

Unexcused skipping of classes

Chronic discipline behavior such as ongoing bullying, cheating, hate speech, leaving class for extended periods of time, sexual harassment, play fighting, inappropriate physical contact, continually disrespectful to adults, chronic violation of cell phone policy etc.

protocols and procedures for being a volunteer, releasing students before the end of the day or coming to visit OG:

All visitors must sign in at the main office and wear a visitor sticker. Between 9:15 am -3:45 pm we try to protect instructional time as much as possible.

Information for Volunteers:

- Volunteers must clear the [Volunteer Background check](#) through PPS Security Services prior to volunteering in the building
- Volunteers are expected to be supporting instruction
- Visits must be planned
- Main office should be notified prior to the schedule visit
- Volunteers should sign in at main office and wear a volunteer badge
- Volunteers should sign out at the main office and return the badge at the end of their day
- Office staff will seek administrative approval prior to sending a volunteer to a classroom if they are not given advance notice of a volunteer's schedule

Information for Visitors:

- Anyone who comes to visit without the intent of supporting instruction is considered a visitor, including parents.
- All family visitors who want to meet with a teacher about their student need to pre-arrange a time with the teacher.
- The principal must approve any other visitors before the intended day of arrival.
- Teachers must notify and seek approval from the principal at least 24 hours prior to the visitor's intended day of arrival.

Early Check-Out for Students

We understand that there are times when a student needs to be released from school before the dismissal bell. They may have an appointment, family emergency or other need to leave school early. This is a reminder about the policy for early check-out:

Students will be released from class when the family member is in the office and the student has been signed out. Office staff will call the classroom for the release. Students are only released to parents, legal guardians, or
