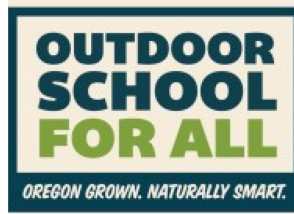
Mock Trial Class News
