Ockley Green MS Cell Phone/Device Policy

THE POLICY

The Ockley Green MS policy for phones and devices is that **all phones/personal devices are powered off and put away the entire school day from 9:10am - 3:45pm.** No phones or personal devices are to be used during class, in the hallways, at lockers, in restrooms or during lunch or recess.

To help with the policy being consistent, all students who bring cellphones/devices to school will check them in with their first/second period teacher. All teachers have been supplied with a lockbox that is cabled to their tech cart. The student's phones will remain locked in the teachers classroom all day and students will return to their 1st/2nd period classroom at 3:45 to retrieve their phone/device.

FAQS

What about IEPs and 504s?

If a student has an IEP or 504 accommodation for device and music use, they will be able to access the accomodation on PPS classroom Chromebooks.

What about busses at the end of the day?

All busses will be held at the end of the day until all students are on board.

What about substitute teachers?

If a teacher has a substitute, an Ockley Green administrator will come to their first/second period class and collect the phones and store them in the school office. Students will come to the office at the end of the day to collect their phones.

What if I need to contact my student or my student needs to contact me?

If students need to contact family members or families need to contact students please do so by using the office phone at 503-916-5660. Families can also text or call any of the administrators if there is an emergency:

CONSEQUENCES FOR NON-APPROVED USE

What happens if a student's phone is out anytime during the school day?

- There will be no more warnings. The student is to respectfully give their phone to the teacher who will lock it in their classroom lockbox.
- 1st time being caught with a non-approved use of a phone: the teacher will collect the phone and store it in their lock box and the student will call home to notify their family. If the student won't give it to the teacher, then an administrator will be called who will collect the phone and call home with the student. The student will retrieve their phone from that teacher (or the office if an administrator was called) who will document this first time, non-approved use on a staff shared

Google doc.

• 2nd Time: the teacher will check the Google doc, then call administration who will come to collect the phone immediately. This is considered a Stage 3/3 referral. The phone will be taken to the office for safe, locked storage. The student's family is contacted and the phone is picked up by family. The student's phone will either stay at home or be locked each morning in the school office for the remainder of the school year.

WHAT ABOUT USING EARBUDS WHILE ON SCHOOL CHROMEBOOKS?

- 1. Students can bring earbuds to school, but only use them in approved classrooms.
- 2. It is up to individual classroom teachers if they allow earbuds or not.
- 3. Students are responsible to understand that teacher's rules around earbud use, and follow them.
- 4. No YouTube use for music. Only Spotify or Pandora.
- 5. Music must be a background screen.
- 6. No Social Media allowed on PPS Chromebooks.
- 7. No earbud use outside of classrooms. Earbuds need to be placed in backpacks or pockets.
