Superintendent Guadalupe Guerrero and Director of PPS Security Services George Weatheroy sent emails last week to families, sharing grief and safety systems in the wake of the tragedies that unfolded at Marjory Stoneman Douglas High School, in Parkdale Florida. I know that events such as these can trigger many feelings for our students, including concern for their own safety.

To that end, I want to reiterate that Ockley Green has a team of specialized staff to support students for a variety of needs. They are our counselors, Ms. Jillian Stone and Mr. Brian Meyer, our Restorative Justice coordinator Ms. Keela Tillery, our school psychologist. TAG/SBAC Waivers

The TAG Department has transitioned to using Smarter Balanced (SBAC) scores for students in 3rd grade and higher who are interested in testing for academic achievement in reading and math. If families choose to opt out of SBAC in spring 2018, their students will not be eligible for TAG nomination in those two categories in fall 2018. Please keep this in mind if you choose to complete a waiver for this spring. The next time a student can be nominated for TAG is next fall.

Neighborhood Safety Project

Following is a message from the Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT):

PBOT is planning a new traffic safety and access project in your neighborhood, and we want to hear from the Ockley Green School community. We will be hosting a listening and learning open house on Tuesday, February 27 at the MLK Jr. School library (4906 NE 6th Ave).

Drop-in at any time between 5-7pm!

The project will improve conditions for bicycling and walking between the Lloyd District and Woodlawn neighborhood, and provide a safe option for people accessing MLK Jr. Blvd. Project elements include slowing traffic speeds, reducing traffic volumes, upgrading crossings of busy streets, and creating new connections to existing bicycle and pedestrian infrastructure.
