




3.60.020-AD Responsibility For Operation

- (1) Responsibility for food procurement, preparation and serving and the general aspects connected therewith resides with the Nutrition Services Department and the offices of the superintendent.
- (2) Principals are responsible for the following areas:
 - (a) Establishing serving schedules including adequate program access and time and space to eat school meals. Minimally, as recommended by nutritionists, after serving, students should be provided with 20 minutes of eating time;
 - (b) Providing supervision of students during meal service times;
 - (c) Providing and selecting student Nutrition Services Program workers;
 - (d) Informing Nutrition Services staff of any special activities affecting the meals program, such as field trips, PTA/PTO meetings, special schedules, outdoor school and other activities;
 - (e) Monitoring compliance with federal law, Board policy and regulation prohibiting the sale of foods of minimal nutritional value and other competitive food sales [from the opening of the school building until 30 minutes after the end of the last regularly scheduled lunch period] [during school breakfast and lunch times in areas where school meals are being served and in areas immediately adjacent to such areas] [in food service areas during times in which school lunch and breakfast are being served and in areas immediately adjacent to such areas during these times]. Such sales may be permitted outside these areas during breakfast and/or lunch meal periods or at other times during the day;
 - (f) Assuring, as part of regular safety inspections and in cooperation with the Director of Nutrition Services, the review of building food service areas of operation for safety, security and sanitation recommendations and corrections, as appropriate;
 - (g) Evaluating building program staff in cooperation with the Director of Nutrition Services.
- (3) Responsibility for compliance with state and federal law in Nutrition Services, building and program wide operations, equipment procurement and maintenance, including program fund expenditures, resides with the Director of Nutrition Services in keeping with established Board policies and regulations.
