

6.50.070-P Non-Academic Credit Learning Programs

- (1) It is recognized that involvement in the ongoing activities of diverse business enterprises, community agencies, and other government and private organizations can provide valuable educational experiences for students. The Board thus encourages the increasing utilization of these resources by schools in designing educational programs appropriate to diverse student needs, interests and abilities.
- (2) The superintendent is hereby directed to establish directives for student participation in non-academic credit programs. Credits earned in such programs shall contribute toward partial fulfillment of graduation requirements. Parental approval for a student's participation in the program is required. Schools shall inform students of opportunities for involvement in non-academic credit programs and of the procedures for participation therein. The district shall provide workers' compensation coverage for students pursuant to ORS 656.033 when the provisions thereof are applicable to the specific activity involved. Transportation on public transit to the place of training shall be provided at district expense, except when the student receives wages or is enrolled exclusively in a non-academic credit program.
