## **PPS DIPLOMA REQUIREMENTS & CAREER EXPLORATION**

In addition to meeting the credit requirements, PPS students demonstrate proficiency in three Essential Skills: Reading, Writing and Mathematics. The primary manner to demonstrate any Essential Skill is to meet in the specified area on the Smarter Balanced Assessment. If students are not able to meet through this option, they can demonstrate their proficiency for an Essential Skill by completing an alternative assessment or work sample. PPS graduates are also required to complete the following three Personalized Learning Diploma Requirements (PLRs):

- 1. Two (2) short reflections on Career Related Learning Experiences
- 2. **Resume**
- 3. My Plan Essay

#### **Fees and Fines**

If students have any overdue books, athletic or band fines, they must be paid in full before being cleared to receive graduation tickets. #### Senior Check-Out

Seniors can begin the check-out process following the senior breakfast and awards ceremony. Seniors will clean out their lockers, turn in books, pay any outstanding fines, and be cleared to graduate.

#### **Graduation Tickets**

After clearing fees, meeting all graduation requirements and completing the check-out process, seniors will receive **15 tickets** each. <u>Please note, families will not be turned away for not</u> <u>having a ticket.</u>

#### **Graduation Mandatory Rehearsal 9:00 AM**

## Graduation Ceremony 7:30 PM

- Graduation rehearsal starts at 9:00 AM and is **REQUIRED**.
- Seniors should arrive at the Coliseum in the Georgia Pacific room (staging area) no later than 6:45 PM
- Students are not allowed to alter their gown and must wear their cap and gown to participate in the graduation ceremony.
- Graduates will receive their diploma immediately following the ceremony in the Exhibit Hall (behind the Georgia Pacific room).
- Families may park in the parking garage at the Coliseum for a fee.
