 - Formative assessments


- Site Council survey provided opportunities for people to share their perspectives; feedback will be shared in spring

Educator Support Systems - Professional Learning Communities (PLCs) and Leadership Team

 PLCs focus on two core protocols: lesson analysis and student work analysis Leadership Team meets to support PLCs

Educator Support Systems: Coaching and Feedback

- Mentor Teachers provide ongoing coaching
- Instructional Coach engages teachers in coaching cycles
- Ongoing instructional rounds; begin including teacher leaders from the Leadership Team in winter and spring



Educator Support Systems: AVID

- AVID is ideal program to impact achievement because it supports staff in increasing student engagement and rigor while providing much-needed scaffolds through WICOR
- In year 1 of AVID implementation
- Goal is to do AVID schoolwide; vision for implementation driven by staff survey



Educator Support Systems: AVID

- AVID Site Team is focused on binders and planners as first schoolwide goal to support organizational skills
- Several supports keep the momentum going: grade-level teams calibrate expectations, schoolwide binder check parties, and quarterly binder checks by department

 AVID Site Team is strategically planning for WICOR strategies over time through staff input and intentional professional development


Inclusive Academic Instruction - Literacy

- IRLA used as a formative assessment for all 6-8 students
- Data provides teachers with an accurate account of a students' reading needs
- ENIL, the Spanish version of IRLA, is used in DLI classrooms
- Sped teachers are trained to use IRLA toolkits for reading support



Inclusive Academic Instruction - Math

- 8th grade math teachers are supported by OTL and a PPS math TOSA to differentiate instruction
- Mathematics Navigator screener administered to all students as a diagnostic tool to inform instruction
- All students use IXL several times a week for guided, individualized practice



Inclusive Academic Instruction

Universal Design For Learning
 (UDL) PD scheduled for 3
 sessions

- UDL will drive shifts in both planning and instruction to better meet the needs of all students

Inclusive Behavior Supports

- Climate team leads PD at least monthly:
 - Reviewed Tier I, II, and III behaviors and responses
- Schoolwide 'expectation stations' held in fall, winter, & spring

- 10/10 rule implemented with fidelity
- Hall sweeps happen on a regular basis to support on-time class attendance
- Implementations of classroom expectations has been the focus

Inclusive Behavior Supports

- Increase in positive school events:
 - Dances
 - School store with PRIDE slips
 - Monthly awards assembly with themes selected by student government

- Site Council is fully engaged and partners with OG staff to improve academic achievement and school climate; group includes a diverse representation of our community
