Event	Frequency	Activity
Site Councils	Monthly	Student, parent, teacher and community representatives from each feeder school will serve on a new Site Council. The Site Council will determine how to implement the school vision using student data and stakeholder input.
Community	Monthly	Monthly community meetings will be held to help design the vision for the new school, find ways to create a united community while honoring feeder school identities, and plan events and transition activities.
Student Events Planning	On-going (To be scheduled after November 29, 2017 meeting)	Planning principals will be conducting regular visits to the feeder schools, meeting with student leadership teams, and organizing school tours and events.
Staff Hiring	2-3 Meetings (To be scheduled after November 29, 2017 meeting)	Community and family members will have opportunities to provide input about the qualities of the middle grades staff members they would like to see at their new middle schools. This group will represent input from community members and report back during Site Council and Community meetings.
Program Engagement	Monthly (To be scheduled after November 29, 2017 meeting)	Community and family members will have opportunities to provide input about curricular and community sponsored programs they would like to see at the new middle schools. This group will represent input from community members and report back during Site Council and Community meetings.
