- Student Body Budget Review - \$ used only to benefit students
- Consolidated Budget – primarily payroll; also includes supplies, books, consumables, printing
- Title 1 Budget = \$90,428
Remaining = \$1,034
Qualify at 40%, Creston is at 33%
Creston will not be identified as Title 1 next year
- Family Involvement Funds = \$2,126
