 - EE2.3 Continuing- PLC work- time for teachers to test out ideas to improve teaching and learning
 - TL4.4- New focus- use assessment data more intentionally- training in using new literacy reporting form- tool was shared at summer literacy institute

-Passport Oregon- partnership to make sure more kids in Title One schools have access to nature. Six 5th graders are participating. Will go to Oregon Coast, Bend, Salem. Had parent orientation, very well received

-Safety issue- homeless people on school playground, talking to Conrad and students. School Resource Officer asked to spend more time on campus. Not much activity on park side.

-New traffic plan- city gave us translated copy of parking map last week. We will be sending home translated map to families. New signs put up by city about 5 minute parking spots, and street by dental clinic is blocked off during pick-up and drop-off.
