Advocates provide 100% confidential support to PPS youth of all genders.

This includes connecting you to resources and walking alongside you regardless of whether you choose to report to law enforcement or participate in a school-based investigation under Title IX.

This unique, one-of-a-kind collaboration is based on a shared vision that everyone deserves to live a life free from violence. We believe that to reach our goal, we must start early in the K-12 years.

### FREE & CONFIDENTIAL

Free, 100% confidential support for all PPS students. Unlike school staff, advocates are **not** mandatory reporters and will never share information without your explicit permission.

## **EQUITABLE RELATIONSHIPS**

We are dedicated to advocating for safe and equitable relationships through educational workshops, trainings, and peer-led programming throughout the Portland Metro area. Workshops are flexible and designed to meet the diverse needs of school communities.

# NON- JUDGEMENTAL

Advocates provide individualized, non-judgmental support to help youth develop coping strategies and can assist with safety planning, attend meetings or medical appointments and/or refer you to other community resources.

#### SCHOOL PROGRAMMING

Advocates empower students, teachers, and parents to change school culture, so everyone understands what healthy, equitable teen relationships look like and how to promote them at school.


#### TITLE IX
