❖ Oregon Administrative Rule 581-022-1620 requires students to take a full course load. Students in 9th through 11th grade will be enrolled in a full schedule.

Forecasting provides you with the opportunity to identify the core courses required for you to graduate as well as *elective* courses available to you that can both enhance and support your school experience. PPS requires 24 credits to graduate. A full schedule of eight classes provides you with the opportunity to take maximum advantage of the educational opportunities. You should carefully review the list of courses available, consult with your parents and counselor as needed, and select 8 courses along with alternate course choices that meet your educational goals.

I am requesting to have an unstructured period in my schedule. I am aware that the expectation is that I will vacate the building when not in class. I understand that it is not acceptable to roam the halls or hang out by my locker.

I understand that if I have forecasted for a PCC Block that I am expected to use the time at PCC or studying for a PCC course. I understand that Study Hall is a non-graded course by attendance is taken daily. If I have a reduced course load, for whatever reason, I will arrive 10 minutes before my first class begins and exit the building immediately following my last class of the day.

I can also choose to go to study hall and sit quietly and study, with campus monitor approval. I understand that if I am not following expectations my schedule may be changed and I will be assigned study hall, instead of my choice schedule.
