



Home Delivery - Operational Safety Plan

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PURPOSE: To ensure that staff who choose to deliver supplies to families are taking the proper measures to mitigate their risk of exposure to COVID-19 and the risk to families receiving supplies.

SCOPE: This procedure applies to any PPS staff conducting a home delivery. Staff must check in with their supervisor prior to conducting a home delivery.

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Staff will wear a face covering and gloves when packaging and delivering supplies to families.
- 2. Staff will contact the family prior to delivery to ensure they are willing to accept the delivery at home.
- 3. When making a delivery, staff will explain to families that supplies must be placed on the ground, a bench, or similar object for families to retrieve. This is in order to maintain physical distance. Staff will continue to wear face coverings and gloves.
- 4. Staff will follow the Professional Conduct Between Adults and Students policy at all times.
- 5. Staff will not drive with any passengers.
- 6. Teachers will record the day, student, and materials delivered in their regular student contact log.
