



McKinney-Vento Operational Safety Plan

Publication Date: April 17, 2020

PURPOSE: To ensure that staff retrieving and delivering essential supplies to families are taking the proper measures to mitigate their risk of exposure to COVID-19 and the risk to families receiving supplies.

SCOPE: This procedure applies to all McKinney-Vento liaisons working at the BESC. Liaisons only enter BESC during their allotted time. Only one liaison at a time is allowed in BESC.

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Liaisons will put on a face covering and gloves before entering BESC, when working with families, and near people.
- 2. Liaisons will enter BESC through L1 parking lot.
- 3. Liaisons collect needed items within their allotted time.
- 4. Liaisons will not leave the Funded Programs office or do work other than retrieve essential supplies.
- 5. Liaisons will deliver essential supplies to families at the school meal sites.
- 6. Liaisons will explain to families that supplies must be placed on the ground, a bench, or similar object for families to retrieve. This is in order to maintain physical distance. Liaisons will continue to wear face coverings and gloves.
- 7. Liaisons will not drive with any passengers.
