BSP and Safety plans in place. If student is on an IEP, School Team reviews IEP to determine applicability of referral to SSC. SIT identifies that student may benefit from referral to SSC for intensive behavioral intervention and support. Admin submits Non-disciplinary screening form with supporting data to SSC. The SSC team determines if referral is appropriate. Approved by Not SSC Staff Approved Administrator meets with Parent-Guardian and student to discuss non-School IEP Team decides how to disciplinary option. carry out IEP & how student will access the general curriculum, Parent-Guardian refuses referral. Parent/Guardian reviews the such as: Return to school for PM brochure, agrees with referral, and classes signs Arrange for home instruction Transportation, if applicable Collect student records and complete SSC referral form and scans it to SSC staff. SIT revisits targeted, tiered interventions with student. SSC Counselor calls family for intake
