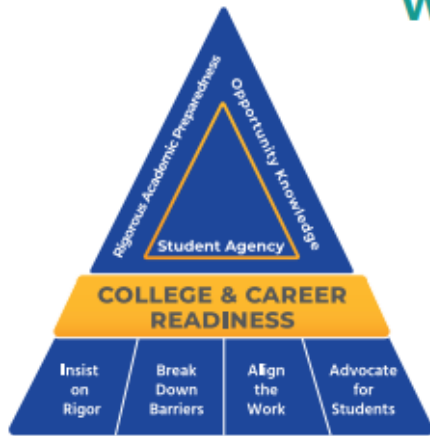

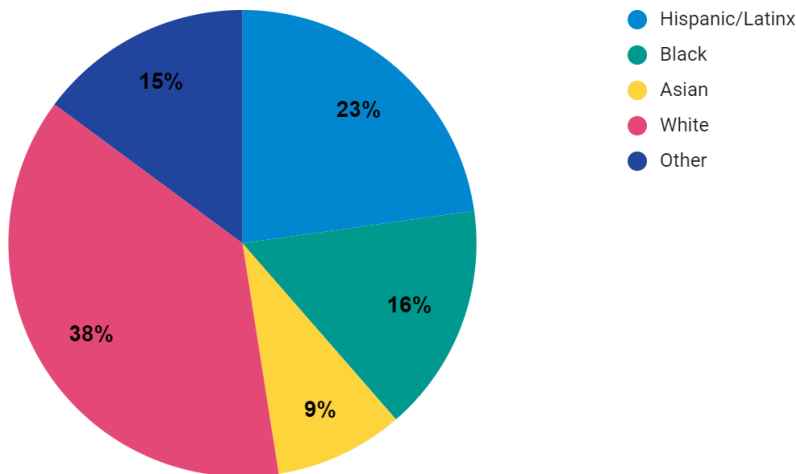

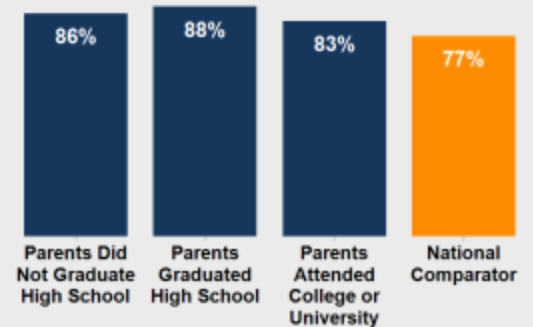
AVID Students Graduated On Time in 2019
