# Education

## Veterinary Technician

- ▶ Two-year degree at Portland Community College
  - ▶ \$12,000.00
- ▶ Can go on to become a Veterinarian
- ▶ Pay: \$32,000-48,000 (starting)
- ▶ Can go on to specialize

## Veterinarian

- ▶ Four years of undergraduate studies
- ▶ Four years of Veterinary School
  - ▶ Overall \$150,000.00-300,000
  - ▶ average debt (2019): \$165,000
- ▶ Pay: \$65,000-90,000 (starting)
- ▶ Can go on to specialize

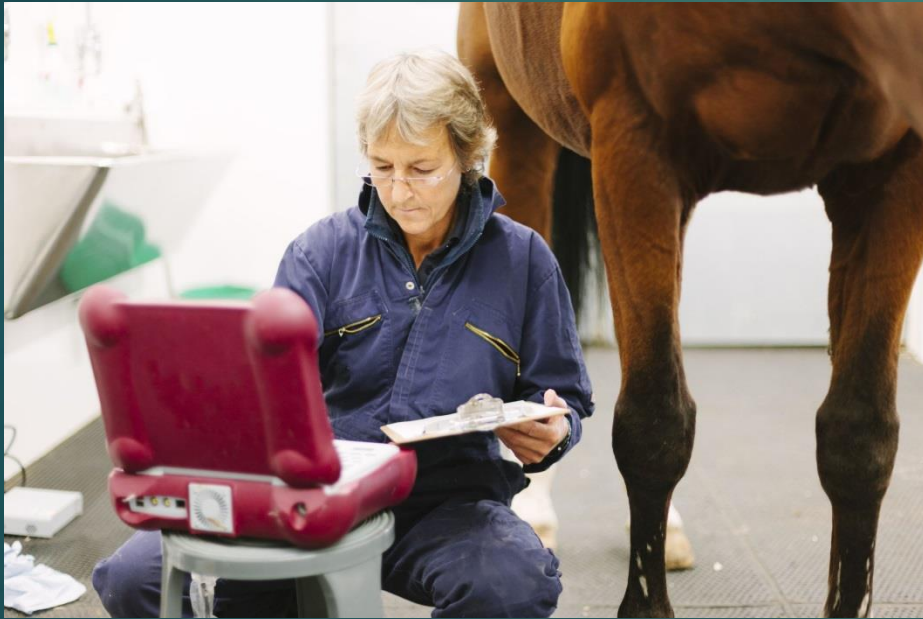

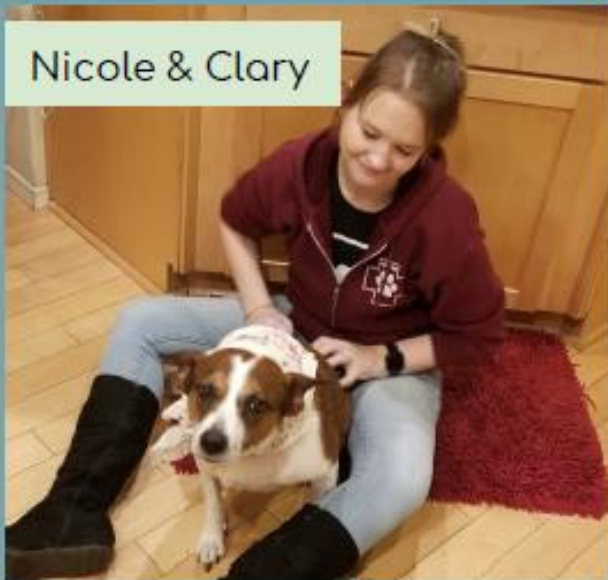

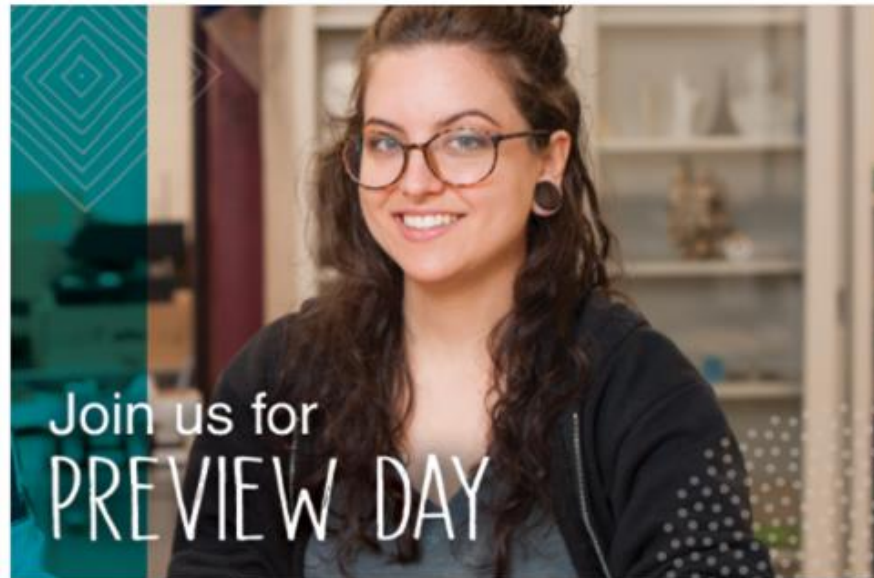
Portland Community College will be hosting a virtual event for high school students to participate in a brief introduction to our programs and services. During Preview Day, you will:
