Dear Class of 2025 families:

Quarter 3 progress reports were completed on February 27th. Be sure to check [ParentVue](#) and review your student's grades. We want you to have all the necessary information to support your student. Reach out to teachers and your counselor if you have questions.

This Wednesday, March 5th is a **scheduled school** day for seniors. It is **NOT** optional. Seniors will attend a senior meeting, complete any missing career-related graduation requirements (Resume, Career Related Learning Experiences, and My Plan essay), work with their Economics or English teacher, and have an opportunity to work on FAFSA and/or Oregon Promise applications!

The prom is also around the corner. To attend, student attendance must be at 80% or better. As a reminder, students may NOT attend Prom if they've been suspended for ANY reason within 2 weeks of the dance. The 60 day rule will also be in effect on April 2nd. The "60 Day Rule" states that a student may be disqualified from commencement and/or commencement related activities if within 60 school days of the last senior school day (May 29, 2025), they are found to be in violation of the district Alcohol or Drug policy **or** any discipline violation that results in a three or more day suspension or more serious disciplinary action. (Reference 4.30.020-AD). Be aware that all school pranks resulting in vandalism or disruption of the school day could also be a violation of this rule, and may result in not being allowed to participate in prom and/or graduation. If students receive disciplinary consequences prior to other school events (Spring Fling, Prom) they will also be excluded from participating.
