- July 26th, 2020 30 year anniversary of the ADA
- July 28th, 2020 PPS Board of Education referred a Bond that includes:
 - \$33.8M for accessibility improvements
 - \$13.4M for Special Education improvements





Accessibility (\$33.8M)	Special Education (\$13.4M)
 Architectural barrier-removal Main-level accessibility District-wide Improvements made to current building code (OSSC 2019) Many priorities remain to be determined 	 Sensory support Physical improvements throughout buildings The scope of this work is actively being developed



Main-Level Accessibility	Remains to Be Determined:
 Why this is an important first step Covers areas of the site including playgrounds, main-level classrooms, cafeteria, gym, and library 	 Where to begin?
