Site Accessibility		
Parking	Where the routes from accessible parking to the accessible entries passes through the vehicular route in the parking lot, provide detectable warnings where pedestrian and vehicular ways meet, and provide a striped route across the vehicular way.	
Parking, On site from Franklin	Two parallel spaces exist with signage on building. The parking dimensions do not meet ADA with adjacent drive aisle. Options include moving one of these spaces to the south of the covered walk and adding an access aisle, and the other to the street with a curb cut to the sidewalk, or adding 2 spaces to the parking lot off of 26 th ave.	
Parking, off site, across 26 th Ave	2 Spaces provided, with ADA and Van space signage and access aisle. Add 3 more ADA spaces and 2 more access aisles. (1 space and access aisle if above option is taken). Extend three access aisle to sidewalk by removing three 4' portions of chain link fence and adding three 3' portions of sidewalks to connect to sidewalk.	
Exterior Ramp	Ramp with Handrails both sides from 28 th Ave to sunken landing between 1958 shop wing and 1968 classroom.	
Portables	Portables are not accessible. Add approx 50' of ramp and deck 5' mid level landing, guard rails one side and hand rails both sides. Add 9' of accessible handrail to stair.

Interior Ramps	Accessible entry connected to ADA ramp with handrails both sides in corridor from H/C entry down to basement. 2nd ramp with handrails on both sides is located in east corridor in basement down to cafeteria. Handrail along west wall is interrupted by door opening. Ramp is less than a 5% slope, so handrails are not required.	
Elevator	Elevator exists in NW corridor.	Norse State Stat
Lift	Two lifts added to gym to allow accessible route to locker and weight rooms.	

Stair Handrails, Interior	No stairs currently have compliant handrails. Provide ADA handrail for one stair to connect all three floors (approximately 112lf of rail.)	
Stair Handrails, Interior	Provide (2) sets of handrails leading from upper gym lobby to locker room and weight room. (Approx 50' total)	
Cafeteria	Provide pull hardware at (2) east exit doors.	
Student Services	Provide lever hardware at door (s).

Gym	Provide an accessible bench with back support at boys and girls locker room.	
Weight Rooms	Move equipment to provide an accessible route to serve all differentiated equipment, and overlapping accessible space to use each piece of equipment.
