Plumbing Elements

Girls 13C	Verify that the fixtures in the room have already been updated to be accessible, as shown in the facility plan, and modify if needed.
Adult Unisex 8C	Convert Room 8C to comply with current accessibility standards for use as an adult accessible restroom (former staff unisex restroom, currently used for storage).
Drinking Fountains	Replace drinking fountain outside Classroom 14 in main N/S corridor with a dual height fountain for children and adults.
Girls Locker	If this room is being used for this function, provide an accessible toilet, stall, grab bars, lavatory, accessories and shower.
Boys Locker	If this room is being used for this function, provide an accessible toilet, stall, grab bars, lavatory, accessories and shower.
Office/Faculty	Provide an accessible sink.

Communication Elements

Cafeteria/Auditorium	Provide assisted listening devices.

Signage	Provide accessible signage at new accessible restrooms and common spaces. If signage is provided at classrooms, provide accessible signage.
