SUMMARY

Benson has a large floor plate that is primarily connected through one elevator. All major program spaces are connected, though some involve a long route. Priority should be given to providing restrooms to all levels for students and teachers, and access to gym support spaces. Also, update individual elements such as science room sinks and lever handles, based on student needs. The major accessibility upgrades for Benson are summarized on this sheet.
