CRESTON ACCESSIBILITY SUMMARY

SUMMARY

Most common areas at Creston are located on the ground floor, with the exception of basement locker, and team rooms. In this instance, the existing building configuration would make the addition of an elevator very difficult even with a major remodel of the basement, and alternate accommodation is recommended. Priority should be given to providing classroom door hardware and a stage ramp. The door hardware, stage ramp and plumbing in the basement comprise the majority of the upgrade work. The major accessibility upgrades for Creston are summarized on this sheet.
