SUMMARY

Most common facilities at Madison are located on accessible floors, but common areas and specialized classrooms are also located in inaccessible areas of the basement. Priority should be given to providing an elevator for basement apparatus room access at this school. The elevator, door hardware and plumbing on floors other than the main level comprise the majority of the upgrade work. The major accessibility upgrades for Madison are summarized on this sheet.
