Rose City Park Facility 2334 NE 57th Avenue Portland, OR 97213

SUMMARY

Most common areas at Rose City Park are located at the ground floor, but common areas are also located on an inaccessible portion of the ground floor and other inaccessible floors. Priority should be given to providing a ramp between ground floor levels, an elevator for multi-floor access and a lift to access the stage area in the auditorium. Each floor will also require accessible bathroom upgrades and drinking fountains as well as door hardware and size verification. The elevator, lift, ramp, door hardware and plumbing on floors will comprise the majority of the upgrade work. The major accessibility upgrades for Rose City Park are summarized on this sheet.
