

## SACAJAWEA ACCESSIBILITY SUMMARY

## SUMMARY

Sacajawea Head Start is a single level building. This facility is currently not accessible and the predominant door size of 30 inches is less than required for an accessible route. Priority should be given to modifying doors to allow required ADA clearance to the north entry and other main doors from common areas such as the playground. Upgrading the girls, boys and faculty restrooms to meet accessibility requirements as well as adding an accessible drinking fountain are also required to meet basic program needs. The accessibility upgrades are predominantly comprised of handrail modifications, door modifications, plumbing fixture modifications and accessible soft play pit surfacing. The major accessibility upgrades for Sacajawea Head Start are summarized on this sheet.
