## SUMMARY

Most common areas at Wilson are located on accessible levels. Priority should be given to providing access to the inaccessible basement locker rooms, wrestling and weight rooms below the gym. Individual elements such as science room counters and lever handles, should also be modified based on student needs. The major accessibility upgrades for Wilson are summarized on this sheet.

Wilson has two exterior swimming pools. To meet new ADA requirements, additional means of access need to be provided. Wilson is one of only a few schools with a pool on school property.
