## New Nurses Office 新しい保健室

This year there is a new delivery of health services in PPS, specifically the Franklin cluster. In the elementary and middle schools you will now find a "student health assistant" (also known as 'SHA') five days a week, 5-7 hours a day. They are trained in courses such as Epi-Pen



administration, medication administration, First Aid/CPR, Glucagon, etc. Their responsibility is the care of all illness and injury needs of the student, and they work in collaboration with the school nurse. The school nurses now take on 5 schools and are assigned to one school per day. The school nurses are now taking on more in depth roles commonly referred to as "case management". The nurse works with administrators and staff to ensure proper staff training on various topics, along with communicating with family to help create "student health management plans" for those students managing complex health needs in the school setting. The school nurse is also available to help families with outreach needs (various community resources). Both the nurse and SHA can be reached by calling the front office or by email.

#### 始業前と放課後の注意事項 Before and After School

All children must be supervised by an adult before the first bell and must be supervised by an adult after 2:15 p.m. If a student is present in the school then he or she needs to be accompanied by an adult. After school, all children should have an adult supervising them on the playground.
