# Letter from our Interim Principal

Dear Richmond Families.

Tomorrow, Thursday, November 10th, our teachers will begin to prepare all the information about your child's academic progress to share with you during your parent/teacher conference on November 21 or 22nd. Please contact your child's teacher as soon as possible if you have not scheduled your conference.

Your conference session with your child's English and Japanese teachers is a very important opportunity for you to ask key questions, such as:

- How is my child progressing toward the Oregon content standards and benchmarks for his/her grade level?
- What are you doing to support my child if he/she is struggling with any aspect of the curriculum?

 What ideas do you have to help me support my child's learning at home?

- How are you extending the curriculum for my child when he/she has mastered the content standard in any area of reading, writing, math, science, etc.?
- How does my child successfully navigate social experiences at school? What can I do to assist my child with social growth?
- How do you use volunteers to help meet the diverse learning needs of your students? How can I get involved to support you in the classroom?

I will be available to talk with you before or after your child's conference if you would like to talk further about any aspect of our curriculum. Please do not hesitate to stop by my office; the door is always open.

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
### STOP BY BARNES AND NOBLE ON NOVEMBER 19TH



## Holiday Scrip News (It's all good!)

Good news: We are now using a new Scrip vendor, Great Lakes Scrip Center. They have a 99.5% rate of filling orders completely the day they are made, with very few, if any, backorders; this means you can make your next Scrip Order with confidence. ALL backorders will be resolved by the next scrip pickup day, November 18<sup>th</sup>.

More good news: Great Lakes carries everything on our order form and more, and most are at a higher profit. Great Lakes has new merchants as well, so I am adding a few to our Order Form. An updated order form may not be available until this weekend, so use the form you now have, adding the new merchants (below) on the form. (check oyanokai.org/fundraising for the latest Order Form)

New Merchants: Build-a-Bear \$25 (8% profit), Amazon. com \$25, (4%), Quizno's \$5 (8%), Arby's \$5 (10%). Dream Dinners scrip is also available at \$100, with 8% profit - I will add it to the order form if there is interest. Casual Corner is no longer available.

Families can now choose to donate scrip funds to the Rich-

mond Foundation instead of their class fund. To do this, indicate "Foundation" in the "class #" space on the form, and near the "star" on the Scrip envelope. You can alternate where the profit goes whenever you like - just make sure it's clear on your order & envelope.

The holiday season is where we make our biggest profits for Oya No Kai and class funds, so please start thinking about using Scrip for gifts and holiday shopping.

Scrip Orders are Tuesday, November 15. Standing orders will be run also. Pick up Scrip on Friday, November 18 at 2:45 in the Richmond Cafeteria, or from your team captain. I will have Scrip available to sell on Friday as well, cash or check only. We don't have everything available on Fridays, so place an order to be sure you get what you want.
