STAFFING UPDATE 今年度の教職員について

We are currently in the middle of hiring two educational assistants. Both positions are 16 hours a week or .4 FTE. Both EAs will largely support the English language kindergarten classrooms and help provide coverage for recess and cafeteria duty during lunch time. We hope to have these individuals hired at Richmond as soon as possible.

Once the new fixtures are in place, they will be tested for lead. If results continue to show unacceptable levels, more work, including pipe replacement, will follow. Please continue to send your child(ren) to school with a water bottle as we will continue to have water coolers in the building.



BEFORE AND AFTER SCHOOL SUPERVISION AND BEING A GOOD NEIGHBOR

As we start a new school year, one important reminder is that all children need to have a parent or guardian with them before and after school. If a student is present in school prior to 8 a.m. and after 2:15 p.m., then they need to be accompanied by an adult. With the exception that Richmond students who ride the bus are permitted to be in the cafeteria before school starts under the supervision of staff.

Another important reminder to consider is the surrounding neighborhood and not blocking neighbors' driveways. A neighbor came into Richmond during the second day of school and was quite upset that his driveway was blocked. He couldn't get out of his driveway to get to work. If you are dropping off your child, please remember to check where you parked so that your car is not impeding our neighbors from getting out of their driveways.

防災準備ミーティング 9月15日(金) 6:30-8:30 p.m.

Have natural disasters like wildfires and hurricanes got you thinking more about your own level of emergency preparedness? Our region is overdue for a large earthquake. We can expect power outages, no phone service, and no clean water. Our roads and bridges will be impassable. Like Hurricane Harvey, our first responders and government agencies will be overwhelmed. Past events suggest that most people in need of help will be rescued by their neighbors. WHAT CAN YOU DO NOW? Get to know your neighbors. Talk about earthquake preparedness. Practice earthquake drills with your kids. Designate a school-area emergency contact for your student(s). Make a family communication plan. WANT TO KNOW MORE? The PTA Emergency Preparedness Committee is kicking off a year of events designed to help you, your family, our neighborhoods, and our school prepare for emergencies. Join guest speakers from PCC and Multnomah County as they present in the Richmond Cafeteria on 9/15. Childcare provided!


Join the Super Green Team!!!
