Hello from the Madison Modernization Project! Check out our **latest update**, which includes a link to two camera views from the site. The end of January saw a lot of progress on site! In the new gym building, construction masonry unit (CMU) blocks are being installed as the weight room, wrestling room, and locker rooms begin to take shape in the lower gym level. In the Administration and Science classroom wing, the concrete slab was poured in January and steel just started getting placed this week! It's a very exciting time at the site!
