Re: Snow route information for the 2019-2020 school year

This document explains how the District will respond during inclement weather and how your big bus service <u>may</u> be affected by snow, ice or other adverse weather conditions. This document also provides information about PPS inclement weather media messages and specific response procedures.

Not all neighborhood schools' bus routes require snow stops or routes during inclement weather. To determine if your school has a snow route please review the table on page 6 of this document or for more current information review the All Schedules & Routes website at www.pps.net/bus or https://sites.google.com/pps.net/gt-bus-schedule/.

Snow routes can be designated to operate for AM or PM (or both) dependent upon road conditions or weather forecast. Please pay close attention to additional District announcements throughout the day for changes. District decisions made after the initial call will be updated to all media outlets.

Inclement Weather Notification & Procedures

Getting Urgent News – Quickly

PPS works to get closures or delay announcements to families quickly and clearly. In addition to notifying the media, we use:

- Automated phone calls: In English and supported languages to the primary phone number listed on your student's registration form. You can change the phone number through your school secretary.
- Online posting: In the "alert pod" on www.pps.net and all school websites.

- Text messaging: Text Sign up for School Messenger by texting YES to 68453

Inclement Weather Information

Safety is of utmost importance during inclement weather conditions.

Every bus stop and route path has been reviewed to determine if an alternate snow stop or route is required. In some cases, regular routes have been reversed or times modified for snow days. Please verify your updated snow routes, as well as regular routes and times here: www.pps.net/bus or https://sites.google.com/pps.net/gt-bus-schedule/.

Things you need to know:

- The announcement of snow routes may be accompanied by a 2 hour late opening or an early closure. Bus times will follow late starts or early dismissals accordingly;
- In the event PPS calls a 2 hour late opening on a day your school has a scheduled late opening, your school will start 2 hours later than your normal bell time not 2 hours later than the late opening time;
- Students should wait for buses at a safe distance from the road during inclement weather conditions;
- Precise stop times are not possible during snow days due to unpredictable traffic delays, so students should be at snow stops early;
- Students should dress warmly and be prepared for longer wait times outside on these days;

- Parents are responsible for the safety of students at bus stops, and should instruct their students on safe walking and waiting procedures;
- Buses are radio-dispatched and equipped with all-weather tires and chains;
- Use the handrails when boarding or exiting the bus to prevent slipping.
- Do not stand or play on snow piles at the bus stop. Do not throw snow-balls at the bus or at anyone.
- Never try to retrieve an item that falls around or underneath the bus. Instead, always report such an incident to the bus driver.
- Never chase after the bus or attempt to grab the back bumper.

Schools With Snow Routes

If you hear an announcement that PPS is running snow routes, use the following table to determine if your regular route has an alternative snow route and associated bus stops. The table below is organized by **School** and **Regular Route Numbers**.

If you do **not** see your school listed or your **Regular Route Number**, it means that your bus will run regular schedules and stops.

If under your school's name you see your **Regular Route Number** then you have snow route and stop. Visit www.pps.net/bus or https://sites.google.com/pps.net/gt-bus-schedule/ to see the Snow Route details.

If you have a Snow Route then please verify your snow route times and stop location on the PPS website: www.pps.net/bus. Snow routes may have different stop locations and times as not all stops are serviceable during inclement weather.
