

The Plan for the New School

A new four-story Cleveland High School will be built on the current school site. The building will be organized into two wings, with classrooms, labs, gyms and performing arts spaces. These wings frame a secure outdoor courtyard at the heart of the school. A welcoming main entry will now be located on SE 28th Avenue, near SE Franklin Street.

Spring 2025 Update

Following the school board's direction to reduce costs, the project team has developed an updated design that **maintains the academic, athletic, and extracurricular spaces that all modernized PPS high schools have.** The cost reductions have resulted in an optimized building layout that reduces basement construction and simplifies the structural and heating/cooling systems. The project team has worked diligently to realize savings while keeping design features that were prioritized by the Cleveland community.

Plan Highlights

- Learning spaces to encourage collaboration and support CHS's International Baccalaureate program
- Two new gyms supported by a dance/wrestling studio and fitness center
- A 500-seat performing arts facility and black box theater
- New band, choir, and art rooms
- A secure exterior courtyard with a covered gathering area
- An energy-efficient, all-electric building that optimizes daylighting
- Upgrades to the CHS stadium and existing parking lot
- Turf softball and baseball fields on other sites

Construction Schedule

Construction funds for the modernizations of Cleveland and Ida B. Wells would need to come from the upcoming School Improvement Bond that is on the May 20th, 2025 election ballot. A construction schedule for Cleveland would be developed pending the outcome of the May 20th election. During the three year construction period, Cleveland students and staff would relocate to the Marshall Campus on 92nd & Powell.
